Dues are set by the board of directors at the annual meeting for the international. Regions or Districts may set their dues to finance their local activities.



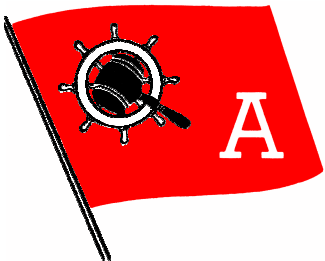
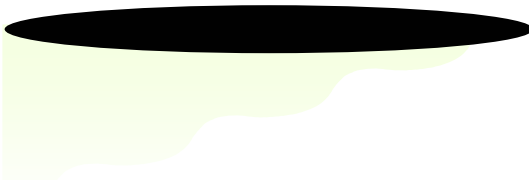
### Publications

The international news letter, the IOBG LOG, is published quarterly.



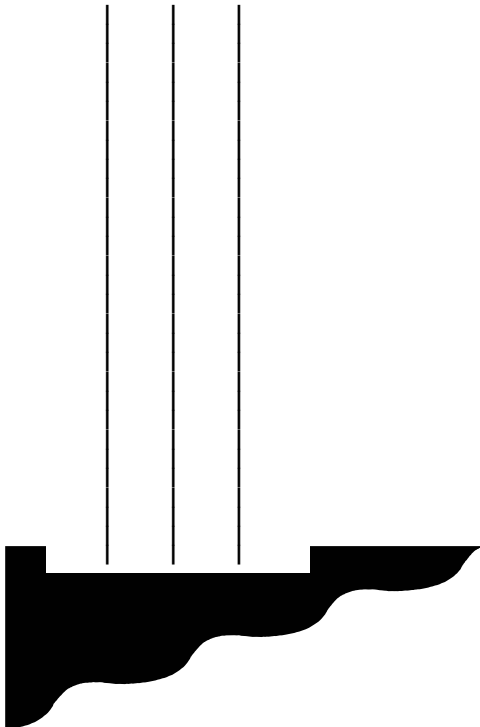
